

FISCAL NOTE

SB 2370 - HB 2343

February 1, 2000

SUMMARY OF BILL: Directs the Department of Transportation to implement a directional signing program on the state and federal highways denoting publicly and privately owned natural wonders and scenic and historical attractions within five miles of the state or federal highway upon which the signs are erected. The regulations shall provide for the department to charge fees sufficient to cover the cost of signing.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Increase State Expenditures – Not Significant/Highway Fund
Increase State Revenues – Not Significant/Highway Fund

Assumes the Department of Transportation, in any given year, would not spend a significant amount of funds for such directional signing program, unless the department was able to charge fees in amounts sufficient to cover the majority of the costs of applicable signs.
