

# **FISCAL NOTE**

## **SB 2530 - HB 2689**

February 20, 2000

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Prohibits a person from working or volunteering as a driver that transports children for a daycare agency if that person is currently charged with or has been convicted of vehicular homicide, an accident involving death, personal injury or an accident involving damage to a vehicle and failure to stop after such an accident. Other convictions that disqualify a person are driving under the influence of drugs or alcohol or any felony involving use of a motor vehicle while under the influence of any intoxicant. Also changes law on beer permits to require a potential licensee to show that the establishment will not interfere with a daycare center that is within 2,000 feet.
