

## **FISCAL NOTE**

### **SB 2633 - HB 2798**

January 31, 2000

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Eliminates the requirement that the records of proceedings regarding the assessment of utilities and carriers be transcribed into a well-bound book and instead requires that the comptroller maintain the records used in such assessments for not less than 7 years. Clarifies code sections where references are made to the Interstate Commerce Commission by replacing these references with the appropriate federal agency.

#### **ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

**Decrease State Expenditures - \$1,000**

Assumes state will experience a decrease in expenditures in the comptroller's office as the comptroller will no longer be required to have certain records transcribed and bound which currently costs approximately \$1,000 annually.
