

FISCAL NOTE

SB 2638 - HB 2514

February 25, 2000

SUMMARY OF BILL: Prohibits any establishment which has its beer permit suspended by the local government authority from selling alcoholic beverages with an alcoholic content higher than beer or malt beverages.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Decrease State Revenues - Not Significant

Decrease Local Govt. Revenues - Not Significant

Estimate assumes any decrease in revenues to state or local governments as a result of revoking alcoholic beverage permits would be not significant.
