**AMEND Senate Bill No. 2129**

**House Bill No. 2061\***

By inserting in subsection (f) of the amendatory language of Section 3 the language ", and authorized," between the language "and is certified as such" and the language "by the chief law enforcement officer".

AND FURTHER AMEND By deleting the effective date section and by substituting instead the following new sections:

SECTION 4. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 55-4-202(c), is amended by deleting subdivision (1)(F) in its entirety and by substituting instead the following:

(F) Emergency services squad, including, but not limited to, emergency medical technicians and paramedics; and

SECTION 5. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 55-4-203(a), is amended by deleting subdivision (4)(B)(iv) in its entirety and by substituting instead the following:

(4)(B)(iv) Emergency services squad, including, but not limited to, emergency medical technicians and paramedics; and

SECTION 6. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 55-4-222(d), is amended inserting the following language between the language "subsequent federal census" and ", upon complying with the title and registration law,":

or who is a resident of this state and is an emergency medical technician or paramedic

SECTION 7. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
