**AMEND Senate Bill No. 710**

**House Bill No. 76\***

by deleting Section 1 of the bill in its entirety and substituting the following in lieu thereof:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 46-2-403(e), is amended by redesignating subsection (e) as (e)(1) and by adding the following as a new subsection to be designated as (e)(2):

(2) For the purposes of this part, procurement cost for interment services, including, but not limited to interment, entombment and inurnment services, shall be actual cost to provide full interment services including but not limited to site preparation, opening of site, site set up, and closing of site, and shall not be lower than the following: one hundred fifty dollars (\$150) for interment services; one hundred dollars (\$100) for entombment services, and forty dollars (\$40) for inurnment services. The basis for determining procurement costs for these services shall be provided to the commissioner annually and verified by audit. The commissioner shall increase such minimum limits by the consumer price index of each calendar year beginning on January 1, 2003.
