**Amendment No. 1 to SB0824**

**AMEND Senate Bill No. 824**

**House Bill No. 559\***

by deleting all the language following the enacting clause and by substituting instead the following:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 70-2-201(g)(3)(D), is amended by deleting the words “or older” and by substituting instead the words “through sixty-four (64) years of age”.

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 70-2-201, is amended by adding the following as a new, appropriately designated subsection:

(\_\_ ) There is hereby created a lifetime senior citizen sportsman license which shall entitle a resident of Tennessee to the same privileges and benefits as provided to an annual sportsman license holder. A lifetime senior citizen sportsman license remains valid throughout the life of the license holder even though the person may become a nonresident. The fee shall be a one-time payment of two hundred dollars (\$200).

SECTION 3. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 70-2-219, is amended by adding the following as a new appropriately designated subsection:

(\_\_ ) Residents of Tennessee sixty-five (65) years of age or older who purchase an annual senior citizen permit and who otherwise comply with the licensing requirements of Section 70-2-201(c)(2), if applicable, enjoy the same additional privileges and benefits as provided to an annual sportsman license holder. The annual fee shall be forty dollars (\$40.00).
