**AMEND Senate Bill No. 660**

**House Bill No. 333\***

By deleting all of the language after the enacting clause and by substituting instead the following:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 29-20-403(b), is amended by deleting subdivision (2) in its entirety and by substituting instead the following:

(2) Minimum limits of not less than two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) for bodily injury or death of any one (1) person in any one (1) accident, occurrence or act, and not less than six hundred thousand dollars (\$600,000) for bodily injury or death of all persons in any one (1) accident, occurrence or act, and seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) for injury or destruction of property of others in any one (1) accident, occurrence or act. The provisions of this subsection shall apply to any action arising on or after July 1, 2001.

SECTION 2. After the state treasurer submits the final report under Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 29-20-110, the general assembly shall review the report and the appropriateness of the levels established by this act.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2001, the public welfare requiring it.
