AMEND Senate Bill No. 2473

House Bill No. 2337*

by deleting all language following the enacting clause and by substituting instead the following:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 7-86-105(b), is amended by adding a new subdivision thereto, as follows:

(7)

(A) Notwithstanding the provisions of this section to the contrary, in any emergency communications district created by a municipality after July 1, 2002, the board of directors of the district may be the legislative body of such municipality. The terms of the members of the legislative body shall run concurrently with their terms as members on the board of directors.

(B) In the event that any member of the emergency communications district board is removed pursuant to the provisions of Section 7-86-314, then the mayor shall appoint a private citizen to serve in the member's place until such time as that member no longer serves on the legislative body of the municipality. Such appointment shall be subject to confirmation by the remaining members of the board of directors of the district.

(C) In the event that the entire emergency communications district board is removed pursuant to the provisions of Section 7-86-314, then the mayor shall appoint private citizens to serve in each member's place until such time as the member no longer serves on the legislative body of the municipality. Such appointment shall be subject to confirmation by the board.

(D) Nothing in this subdivision shall be construed to be contrary to the provisions of Section 7-86-310.
