

HOUSE BILL 1350

AN ACT to amend TCA § 57-4-203 relative to the sale of beverages of alcoholic content of not more than five percent (5%), by weight, to minors.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

Section 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 57-4-203(b), is amended by deleting subsection (1) in its entirety and inserting instead the following language as new subdivisions and renumbering the remaining subdivisions appropriately:

“(1) It is unlawful for any licensee or other person to sell, furnish, dispose of, give, or cause to be sold, furnished, disposed of, or given, any alcoholic beverage to any person under twenty-one (21) years of age.

(2) It is unlawful for any licensee or other person to sell, furnish, dispose of, give, or cause to be sold, furnished, disposed of, or given, any beer/malt beverage as defined in § 57-6-102 to any person under twenty-one (21) years of age.”

(3) A violation of subdivision (b)(1) or (2) of this subsection is a Class A misdemeanor.”

Section 3. This act shall take effect on becoming law, the public welfare requiring it.
