

HOUSE BILL 1909

AN ACT to designate a bridge spanning Fork Creek on State Route 72 in Loudon County in memory of William Broady Harrison.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the bridge spanning Fork Creek on State Route 72 near the Loudon County/Monroe County line is hereby designated as the "William Broady Harrison Memorial Bridge".

SECTION 2. The department of transportation is directed to erect suitable signs or to affix suitable markers designating such bridge as the "William Broady Harrison Memorial Bridge".

SECTION 3. The erection of such signs or markers shall be within the guidelines prescribed by the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices.

SECTION 4. This act shall become operative only if Loudon County, Tennessee, remits the estimated cost of the erection of such signs to the department of transportation within one (1) year of the effective date of this act. Loudon County shall make such payment prior to any expenditure by the state for manufacture or installation of such signs. The department shall return any unused portion of the estimated cost to Loudon County within thirty (30) days of the

erection of such signs. If the actual cost exceeds the estimated costs, Loudon County shall remit an amount equal to the difference in such costs to the department within thirty (30) days of receiving an itemized invoice of the actual cost from the department.

SECTION 5. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
