HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION 746

A RESOLUTION to propose an amendment to Article II, Section 18, of the Constitution of Tennessee, relative to the General Assembly.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ONE HUNDRED SECOND GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, THE SENATE CONCURRING, That a majority of all the members of each house concurring, as shown by the yeas and nays entered on their journals, that Article II, Section 18, of the Constitution of Tennessee be amended by inserting the language ", including a bill to enact a tax measured by income," between the words "A bill" and the words "shall become law"; and by adding the following new language at the end of the section:

No bill to raise the rate of sales tax or any tax measured by income, once both such taxes have been imposed and are in effect, or to create new exemptions or increase any exemptions from sales tax or any tax measured by income, shall become law unless, on third and final consideration, it has received the assent of three-fifths (3/5)

of all the members elected to the House of Representatives and three-fifths (3/5) of the members elected to the Senate.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the foregoing amendment be referred to the One Hundred Third General Assembly, and that this resolution proposing such amendment be timely published by the Secretary of State in accordance with the Constitution of Tennessee, Article XI, Section 3.
