

HOUSE RESOLUTION 143

A RESOLUTION To create a special House committee to study the administration of the Senior Community Service Employment Program for Older Americans.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ONE HUNDRED SECOND GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, THE SENATE CONCURRING, That there is hereby created a special House committee to study the feasibility and appropriateness of transferring the administration of the Senior Community Service Employment Program for Older Americans, and all associated programs, services and administrative functions, from the Commission on Aging to the Department of Labor and Workforce Development.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the committee shall consist of five (5) members of the House of Representatives, to be appointed by the Speaker of the House.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That all appropriate state agencies shall provide assistance to the special House committee upon request of the chair.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That all legislative members of the special House committee who are duly elected members of the General Assembly shall remain members of such committee until the committee reports its findings and recommendations to the General Assembly.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the special House committee shall be convened by the member with the most years of continuous service in the General Assembly, and at its first meeting shall elect a chair, vice-chair, and such other officers the committee deems necessary.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the special House committee shall timely report its findings and recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the One Hundred Second General Assembly no later than February 1, 2002, at which time the committee shall cease to exist.
