

SENATE BILL 302

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 4, relative to the erection of signs for state capital projects.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1.

(a)

(1) The state department or agency that is responsible for the management or oversight of a particular state capital improvement project, including a capital project in which the state has a significant monetary, infrastructure or other investment, shall provide for the erection of appropriate signage at such capital project.

(2) Such signage shall include, but shall not be limited to, the name and district number of each member of the general assembly whose district, in whole or in part, lies within the physical area in which such capital project is located.

(b) To the maximum extent possible, the bidding specifications for a state capital project shall include provisions for the erection of the signage required by this act.

SECTION 2. The commissioner of finance and administration is authorized to promulgate rules and regulations to effectuate the purposes of this act. All such rules and regulations shall be promulgated in accordance with the provisions of Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 4, Chapter 5.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2001, the public welfare requiring it.
