

SENATE BILL 584

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 39, Chapter 17, relative to criminal offenses and penalties.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 39-17-417(i), is amended by deleting the word "or" at the end of subdivision (12); by deleting the period at the end of subdivision (13) and substituting instead a semicolon and the word "or"; and by adding the following language as a new subdivision to be designated as follows:

(14) Twenty-five (25) grams or more of any substance containing DMA as defined in Section 39-17-406(d) or MDMA as defined in Section 39-17-406(g).

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 39-17-417(j), is amended by deleting the word "or" at the end of subdivision (12); by deleting the period at the end of subdivision (13) and substituting instead a semicolon and the word "or"; and by adding the following language as a new subdivision to be designated as follows:

(14) One hundred (100) grams or more of any substance containing DMA as defined in Section 39-17-406(d) or MDMA as defined in Section 39-17-406(g).

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect January 1, 2002, the public welfare requiring it.
