SENATE BILL 660

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 29, relative to  
civil remedies.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 29-7-101, is amended by adding the  
following language as a new, appropriately designated subsection:

(\_) Whenever any judgment creditor has reasonable grounds to believe that any  
third party may possess or harbor property of a judgment debtor, such creditor may  
serve interrogatories substantially in compliance with Rules 26 through 37 of the  
Tennessee Rules of Civil Procedure upon said third party relative to recovery of the  
assets of the judgment creditor. Said interrogatory shall be reasonably limited to issues  
relative to the recovery of assets, chattels, or property of the judgment debtor for  
purpose of satisfying said judgment.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2001, the public welfare requiring it.
