

SENATE BILL 1266

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 55-50-321, relative to information required to be submitted to obtain a driver license.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 55-50-321(c)(1), is amended by inserting the language "if the applicant has been issued a social security number," between the language "social security number," and the words "and whether".

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 55-50-321(b), is amended by adding the following language at the end of the subsection:

In addition, if the applicant is not a citizen of the United States, the driver license examiner is authorized to accept any of the following documents for identification purposes: authentic document from the Immigration and Naturalization Service; alien registration receipt card; resident alien card; employment authorization card; temporary resident card; OMB 3116-0008 certificate of eligibility for exchange visitors; OMB 1115-0051 certificate of eligibility for non-immigrant; military papers issued by the defense department of a foreign country; any type of generally recognized governmental registration document issued by a governmental agency of a foreign country; a voter identification card issued by a governmental agency of a foreign country; or any other

certificate or document issued by the government of a foreign country or business entity located in a foreign country if such certificate or document includes a photo of the person to whom the certificate or document has been issued.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
