

SENATE BILL 1793

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 68, Chapter 140, relative to emergency services.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 68-140-506(f), is amended by deleting the language "Licenses and permits shall expire on December 31 of the year of issuance." and by substituting instead the following:

Licenses and permits shall be valid for a period of up to two (2) years. The department shall establish a system of license and permit renewals that will allow for the distribution of the workload. The fee imposed for any license or permit issued under the interval method shall be proportional to biennial fees adopted pursuant to this part. The fee imposed under the interval method for a period of other than twenty-four (24) months shall be proportional and shall be rounded to the nearest dollar.

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 68-140-517(c), is amended by deleting the language and punctuation "which shall not exceed twenty-five dollars (\$25.00).".

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
