

SENATE BILL 2368

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 9, Chapter 4,  
relative to the state budget.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 9-4-5101(a), is amended by deleting the language "all proposed expenditures" and substituting the language "all proposed expenditures of state levied taxes".

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 9-4-5101, is amended by deleting subsection (c) and substituting the following:

(c) The budget shall set forth the anticipated revenues of state government from taxes levied by the state, and shall also show other funds anticipated from other sources. Expenditures by the state from state-imposed taxes shall be presented in the budget and other expenditures may be listed to the extent required by law. No reappropriation of earmarked federal funds, dedicated fees, or other receipts which are statutorily mandated for specific expenditures is required.

SECTION 3. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 9-4-5106(a)(1), is amended by deleting the fourth through the sixth lines thereof and substituting the following:

it shall also embrace a summary of anticipated receipts and appropriations of state levied taxes

SECTION 4. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 9-4-5106(a)(2), is amended by deleting the language “expenditures and revenues” and substituting the language “expenditures and revenues of state levied taxes”.

SECTION 5. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
