

SENATE BILL 2833

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 2, Chapter 2,
relative to voter registration.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 2-2-115(b)(7), is amended by
inserting the following after the language "proof of identity":

and proof of United States citizenship.

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 2-2-116(c), is amended by deleting
the language "5. Social Security number, if any" and by substituting instead the language "5.
Social Security number".

SECTION 3. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 2-2-120, is amended by deleting the
section in its entirety and by substituting instead the following:

Section 2-2-120. The administrator of elections shall determine, from the
registrant's answers to the questions on the permanent registration record and other
questions, if necessary, and by witnessing documentary proof of United States
citizenship, whether the registrant is entitled to register. Pursuant to the authority
granted by § 2-11-201, the coordinator of elections shall determine acceptable
documentary proof of United States citizenship. If the administrator determines that the

registrant is entitled to register, the administrator shall declare the registrant a registered voter.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
