AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 58, relative to military forces.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 58-1-235, is amended by deleting the section in its entirety and by substituting instead the following:

Section 58-1-235. (a) Any person who contributes to a company fund of the Tennessee national guard in an amount set by the commander in chief shall be known as a patron of the national guard. The names of all such patrons, together with the amount contributed by each, shall be reported to the adjutant general who shall issue an appropriate card identifying such contributor as a friend, patron and supporter of the national guard.

(b) The amount set by the commander in chief pursuant to subsection (a) of this act and any subsequent changes thereto shall be reported to the state comptroller on a yearly basis.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2002, the public welfare requiring it.
