

SENATE BILL 3213

AN ACT to amend Chapter 70 of the Private Acts of 1971; as amended by Chapter 68 of the Private Acts of 1979; and any other acts amendatory thereto, relative to Robertson County highway commission zones.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of Chapter 70 of the Private Acts of 1971, as amended by Chapter 68 of the Private Acts of 1979, and any other acts amendatory thereto, is amended by deleting such section in its entirety and substituting instead the following:

SECTION 1. There is established for Robertson County, Tennessee, six (6) separate highway zones, from which shall be elected the members of the County Highway Commission as set forth in Section 2 below. These zones shall be established by the Robertson County Commission in such manner that the six (6) zones generally contain an approximate equivalent number of county citizens. The zones may be established by combining County Commission Districts or by such other manner as determined by the County Commission, and the zones may change in their boundary from time to time for this purpose.

SECTION 2. This act shall have no effect unless it is approved by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the legislative body of Robertson County. Its approval or nonapproval shall be proclaimed by the presiding officer of the legislative body and certified to the secretary of state.

SECTION 3. For the purpose of approving or rejecting the provisions of this act, it shall be effective upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it. For all other purposes, it shall become effective July 1, 2002, if approved in accordance with Section 2.
