

SENATE RESOLUTION 221

A RESOLUTION to create a special senate committee to study issues pertaining to the proposed licensing of surgical technologists.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDRED SECOND GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, That there is hereby created a special senate committee to study issues pertaining to the proposed licensing of surgical technologists.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the committee shall study, receive testimony, deliberate upon and make recommendations regarding the licensing of surgical technologists.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the committee shall consist of three (3) legislative members. The speaker of the senate shall appoint three (3) legislative members of the committee from the senate general welfare committee.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the committee shall be convened by the legislative member with the most years of continuous legislative service, and, at its organizational meeting, shall elect from its membership, a chair, vice-chair and such other officers, as it may deem necessary. The committee shall meet during the organizational session of the One Hundred Third General Assembly.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That all appropriate state agencies shall provide assistance to the special senate committee upon request of the chair.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That all legislative members of the special senate committee who are duly elected members of the General Assembly shall remain members of such committee until the committee reports its findings and recommendations to the General Assembly.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the special senate committee shall timely report its findings and recommendations, including any proposed legislation or interim reports, to the One Hundred Third General Assembly by February 1, 2003, at which time the committee shall cease to exist.
