

# FISCAL NOTE

## HB 1354 - SB 1631

March 10, 2001

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Authorizes the Alcoholic Beverage Commission to promulgate necessary rules and regulations pursuant to the Grape and Wine Law, governing the production, sale and transportation of wine and to conduct investigations and audits as may be necessary for enforcement. Requires notification by the Department of Revenue of noncompliance of the state's tax laws and authorizes the Alcoholic Beverage Commission to revoke or suspend a winery's license for noncompliance.

### ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

**Increase State Expenditures - Not Significant**

**Increase State Revenues - Not Significant**

**Increase Local Govt. Revenues - Not Significant**

Estimate assumes:

- an increase in state expenditures in the Alcoholic Beverage Commission to enforce the provisions contained in the bill.
- an increase in expenditures in the Department of Revenue to provide notification to the Alcoholic Beverage Commission of noncompliance of taxpayers.
- a not significant increase in revenues realized by state and local governments to the extent that additional taxes are collected that would not have been collected in the absence of the bill.
