

FISCAL NOTE

HB 2105 - SB 2525

February 14, 2002

SUMMARY OF BILL: Allows qualified school personnel to receive training in the administration of glucagon. School personnel so trained would be permitted to administer the shot in emergency situations to students or other school personnel. The training program would be arranged through the Department of Health and coordinated by the Department of Education.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Increase State Expenditures - \$309,400 Recurring

\$56,400 One-Time

Increase Local Govt. Expenditures - Exceeds \$100,000

Estimate assumes:

- The Department of Health is required to provide the training and will need six new positions and related expenses to provide such training.
- There will be some cost to arrange the training for non-licensed personnel in over 2,000 local schools. The use of non-licensed personnel in local education agencies may increase the cost of liability insurance. The amount cannot be determined but is estimated to exceed \$100,000.
