

FISCAL NOTE

HB 2829 - SB 2926

February 9, 2002

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires a referendum of the voters of any local government in which a private act hospital authority is located for the approval of the sale, lease, or other transfer of assets, buildings and real property of the hospital owned by the county or municipality. Specifies certain conditions under which such referendum would not be required.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Increase Local Govt. Expenditures - Not Significant

Estimate assumes to the extent a referendum is required under the provisions of the bill, the local government will experience an increase in expenditures for costs associated with the referendum. This increase is estimated to be not significant as the estimate assumes the referendum would be held in conjunction with a regularly scheduled election.
