

FISCAL NOTE

HB 2907 - SB 2954

February 18, 2002

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires the Department of Human Services, by August 31, 2002, to provide additional information in a monthly notice to the custodial parent or other caretaker of a child who receives child support payments. The bill also requires an expansion of the persons receiving this monthly notice to include: former Aid to Families with Dependent Children recipients, Title IV-D child support services recipients and any other persons who receive payments from the DHS central collections unit. Current law requires notices, by April 1, 2002, containing less information to current and former Families First recipients.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Increase State Expenditures - \$62,700

Other Fiscal Impact - Increase Federal Expenditures - \$121,700

Current law requires DHS to provide notices with less information and to fewer recipients than required by this bill. The estimated fiscal impact includes expenditures above and beyond that required by current statute.
