

# FISCAL NOTE

## HJR 53

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Creates a special joint committee to study the various public safety and health risks associated with methyl tertiary butyl ether (MTBE). This special joint committee, consisting of 3 Representatives and 3 Senators, shall timely report its findings and recommendations no later than February 1, 2002 at which time the committee shall cease to exist.
