

FISCAL NOTE

SB 458 - HB 1137

February 16, 2001

SUMMARY OF BILL: Specifies that members of the boards of directors of emergency communications districts shall serve until a successor is duly appointed and confirmed. Clarifies that the state Emergency Communications Board after reviewing the financial statements of a financially distressed emergency communications district may prescribe a rate structure aimed at remedying the failure of the district to produce sufficient revenues.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

MINIMAL

Estimate assumes the bill provides clarification for the authority of the Emergency Communications Board and does not affect revenues or expenditures.
