SB 962 - HB 1011

March 12, 2001

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires the grand jury in each county to investigate every case of sudden, unexplained death of a child, aged 12 and under, which occurs during the period for which the grand jury is impaneled.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Increase Local Govt. Expenditures - Not Significant

Estimate assumes such investigations would take place in the normal course of the proceedings of an impaneled grand jury and any increase in expenditures would be not significant.
