

FISCAL NOTE

SB 1008 - HB 1880

April 17, 2001

SUMMARY OF BILL:

- Requires the Commissioner of Correction to create a pilot program to reduce violence in prisons and jails by use of audiovisual surveillance.
- Requires the department to select one prison and one local jail under contract to house state felons for the project.
- Requires the commissioner to make three reports on the pilot program to the Select Oversight Committee on Corrections.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

**Increase State Expenditures - \$98,000 One-Time
\$5,000 Recurring**

Assumes one-time cost of audiovisual equipment and a recurring cost for maintenance.
