

# FISCAL NOTE

## SB 1382 - HB 1108

February 27, 2001

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Requires bounty hunters to attend annually at least 8 hours of training conducted by the Department of Commerce and Insurance. Requires the Department to issue pocket cards to bounty hunters verifying completion of such training.

### ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

**Increase State Revenues - \$80,000**  
**Increase State Expenditures - \$76,500 Recurring**  
**\$5,000 One-Time**

Estimate assumes:

- one position in the Department of Commerce and Insurance with salary and benefits of \$37,500.
- an increase in state expenditures of \$39,000 for curriculum development, training facility and firing range rental, and administrative expenses to operate the training program.
- a one-time increase in state expenditures of \$5,000 for office equipment and furniture.
- fee for course will be set at an amount to cover costs of training program resulting in an increase in state revenues of approximately \$80,000.
