

FISCAL NOTE

SB 1733 - HB 1839

April 8, 2001

SUMMARY OF BILL: Gives the court discretion in deciding whether to grant a request to expunge a person's criminal record when the charge is a sexual offense and it has been dismissed or a nolle prosequi is entered. Provides that the court should consider the totality of the circumstances and facts of the case and the reason for the dismissal to balance due process and public security. Under current law, these records are required to be expunged upon request of the person.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Increase State Expenditures - Not Significant

Assumes additional court time will be required to review these cases.
