

FISCAL NOTE

SB 2255 - HB 2511

February 5, 2002

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires that every employer who establishes a drug-free workplace program:

- shall have at least one complete, current copy of the law which regulates such programs, as well as a complete, current copy of all rules promulgated and revised which effect those employers;
- shall post a notice, in a conspicuous place easily accessible to employees, informing employees (a) that the Law, Rules and other information about the program are available, (b) and of the procedure to follow if the employee wants to review the law, rules and information during working hours and or obtain a copy of them; and shall provide, at the time of employment, the information during working hours and/or obtain a copy of them; and (3) shall provide, at the time of employment, the opportunity for every employee to review the law applicable to covered employers, as well as all promulgated rules.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Increase State Expenditures - Not Significant
