

FISCAL NOTE

SB 2291 - HB 2677

February 23, 2002

SUMMARY OF BILL: Increases the minimum pay for poll officials on election day from fifteen (\$15) dollars a day to twenty-five (\$25) dollars a day.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Increase Local Govt. Expenditures - Not Significant

Currently, a county commission may raise the pay of poll officials above the minimum. It is not believed that many counties currently pay less than \$25 a day. To the extent those local governments who are not paying \$25 a day must raise their daily rate, local government expenditures are estimated to increase; however, such increase is estimated to be not significant.
