

FISCAL NOTE

SB 2411 - HB 2923

February 18, 2002

SUMMARY OF BILL: Specifies that information maintained on a computer or removable computer storage media by the assessor of property in any county having a population in excess of 800,000 according to the 2000 or any subsequent federal census (Shelby), including records of the final assessment of property, shall be made available to the public during normal business hours with printouts or photocopies available within 30 days of a request at a reasonable cost to cover the expense of such copies. Current law specifies that such information shall be made available to the public within 30 days of a request.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

MINIMAL

Estimate assumes records are already required to be open for public inspection in accordance with T.C.A. 10-7-121(a)(1)(A). Under current law the affected county can charge a fee for providing copies of information requested. Estimate assumes provisions of bill provide clarification of existing law.
