

## **FISCAL NOTE**

### **SB 2487 - HB 2505**

February 14, 2002

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Authorizes persons acting as good Samaritans who believe they may have been exposed to potentially life-threatening airborne or bloodborne diseases to be evaluated for such exposure.

#### **ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

##### **Increase Local Expenditures – Not Significant**

Current law requires the responding agency to be responsible for such testing and covers emergency medical technicians, paramedics, similar workers and volunteers. Current law makes the local agency responsible for such testing. Local governments will experience an increase in expenditures but the amount is estimated to be not significant.
