

# FISCAL NOTE

## SB 2765 - HB 2696

February 5, 2002

### SUMMARY OF BILL:

- Provides that a licensed fire protection sprinkler system contractor must install fire pumps, valves and fire hydrants.
- Clarifies that a person who actually installs or services a fire protection sprinkler system must be a licensed fire protection sprinkler system contractor.
- Authorizes owners of property on which fire protection sprinkler systems are installed to perform simple maintenance on such sprinkler systems.
- Clarifies the definition for "installation."

### ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

**Increase State Revenues - Not Significant**

**Increase State Expenditures - Not Significant**

Estimate assumes that:

- any increase in state revenues generated from licensing fees from persons who must obtain a license under the provisions of this bill will not be significant.
- any increase in state expenditures to implement the provisions of this bill will not be significant.
