SUMMARY OF BILL:

- Proposes to amend Article I of the Constitution of Tennessee to provide that any right to an abortion in Tennessee shall only be such as is protected under the United States Constitution as interpreted by the United States Supreme Court, from time to time. Nothing in this Constitution shall be interpreted to require that any state funds be appropriated by the state to fund or pay for any abortion.
- Provides that the foregoing amendment shall be referred to the 103rd General Assembly and be published by the Secretary of State in accordance with Article XI, Section 3 of the Constitution of Tennessee.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Increase State Expenditures - \$20,000 One-Time

Assumes a cost of \$20,000 to the Secretary of State to print notice of the proposed amendment in certain newspapers as required by this resolution.
