

HOUSE BILL 3055

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 10-7-504, relative to extending the protections afforded to records in the possession of municipal and county attorneys.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 10-7-504(a)(5), is amended by adding the following language as a new subdivision (D):

(D) Books, records, and other materials in the possession of a county attorney or a municipal attorney that relate to any pending or contemplated legal or administrative proceeding in which the county attorney or municipal attorney may be involved on behalf of the county or municipality represented are confidential and not subject to public disclosure to the same extent as provided in subdivision (A) for books, records, and other materials in the possession of the state attorney general and reporter.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
