

# FISCAL NOTE

## HB 2721 - SB 2755


**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Prohibits rules or regulations directly impacting legislation enacted in the preceding session of the General Assembly from being filed with the Secretary of State when the General Assembly is not convened and conducting business. This would not apply to emergency and public necessity rules.

### ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

**Other Fiscal Impact - Any prohibition against rules or regulations being filed with the Secretary of State directly impacting certain legislation as outlined in the bill could result in the forgoing of state revenues and preventing state expenditures from being incurred until such time as rules could be filed with the Secretary of State. Such impact on expenditures and revenues could be significant.**
