

FISCAL NOTE

SB 182 - HB 1393

January 14, 2004

SUMMARY OF BILL:

- Requires the Fiscal Review Committee to monitor certain litigation for which notice has been given by the Attorney General and to issue written comments concerning the fiscal impact about such litigation.
- Adds each member of the Fiscal Review Committee to the list of people to whom the Director of the Fiscal Review Committee must report any litigation that is likely to result in a significant increase in state expenditures.
- Prohibits the Speaker of the Senate and the Speaker of the House from giving approval to the settlement of certain litigation without first having received comments from the Fiscal Review Committee.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Increase State Expenditures - Not Significant

Any increase in state expenditures to implement and monitor the provisions of this bill is estimated to be not significant.
