

FISCAL NOTE

SB 291 - HB 670

February 11, 2003

SUMMARY OF BILL: Specifies that violation of the Passenger Contract Carrier Safety Act is a Class C misdemeanor. Requires drivers employed by contract carriers to maintain a daily log book detailing hours worked. Requires the log book for the past 30 days be in the driver's possession when on duty and made available for inspection by a law enforcement officer or passenger.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Increase State Revenues - Not Significant

Increase Local Govt. Revenues - Not Significant

Increase Local Govt. Expenditures - Not Significant

Estimate assumes:

- increase in state revenues from fines levied and collected under the provisions of the bill.
- increase in local government expenditures depends on the number of persons convicted of the offense who are incarcerated and the cost to the local governments to confine such persons.
- clerks receive commission on fines collected.
