

FISCAL NOTE

SB 1858 - HB 1895

March 13, 2003

SUMMARY OF BILL: Authorizes the State Board of Equalization to assess the actual costs of a hearing or processing an appeal against any appellant not determined to be indigent pursuant to the rules of the Board.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Increase State Revenues - Exceeds \$70,000

Estimate assumes:

- approximately three-fourths of the Board's budget or \$600,000 relates to appeals.
- the Board would establish a fee to cover only appeal processing and travel costs, at rates based upon the type of property involved, resulting in an increase in revenues estimated to exceed \$70,000 annually.
