SUMMARY OF BILL: Memorializes the United States Congress to amend the Constitution of the United States stating that marriage in the United States shall consist only of the union of a man and a woman and neither this constitution, the constitution of any state, nor state or federal law, shall be construed as requiring that marital status or the legal incidents thereof be conferred upon unmarried couples or groups. Requests that such amendment be sent to the several states for proper ratification and that enrolled copies of this resolution be sent by the Chief Clerk of the Senate to the Tennessee delegation of the U.S. Congress and to the Speaker and the Clerk of the United States House of Representatives and the President and the Secretary of the United States Senate.


