by deleting the language of section 4 in its entirety and substituting the following language in its place:

SECTION 4. Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 63, Chapter 1, Part 1, is amended by inserting the following as a new, appropriately designated section thereto:

Consistent with this act and their respective practice acts, the boards of the respective branches of the healing arts shall promulgate rules and regulations, in accordance with the provisions of title 4, chapter 5, and of their respective practice acts, to regulate the nature, manner, content, and extent of advertising and the use of titles by practitioners of such healing arts who are under the jurisdiction of such boards, including advertising pertaining to board certification and specialty. Those boards which have already adopted such rules and regulations are not required to adopt additional rules and regulations unless and until deemed necessary and appropriate by those boards.

AND IS FURTHER AMENDED by deleting the language of section 6 in its entirety.
