AMEND Senate Bill No. 3190

House Bill No. 2928*

by deleting the amendatory language of Section 1, subdivision (a)(1), and by substituting instead the following language as a new subdivision (a)(1):

(1) After July 1, 2006, all municipal, county and state employed plumbing and mechanical inspectors having jurisdiction to enforce the provisions of this chapter shall receive certification from the state fire marshal before enforcing applicable building codes; provided, however, that the certification required by this section shall not be required of state employed plumbing and mechanical inspectors until July 1, 2008. An application for certification shall be filed with the state fire marshal on a form to be developed by the state fire marshal. Plumbing and mechanical inspectors employed on July 1, 2006, shall have up to twenty-four (24) months to receive certification, and any plumbing and mechanical inspectors hired after July 1, 2006, shall have up to twelve (12) months from the date of employment to receive certification. The state fire marshal shall promulgate rules and regulations pursuant to the Uniform Administrative Procedures Act, compiled in title 4, chapter 5, relative to the standards and qualifications for certification. Such rules and regulations shall require proof satisfactory to the state fire marshal that the candidate understands all applicable building codes.
