

SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 634

A RESOLUTION to designate Bell Buckle Motorcycle Days, as  
"The Official Tennessee Bike Show  
Championship."

WHEREAS, many thousands of Tennessee residents and visitors enjoy motorcycling as an energy-efficient mode of transportation and as an enjoyable recreational activity; and

WHEREAS, cycling possesses a particular allure; indeed, many enthusiasts speak of riding in philosophical terms as they attempt to convey the singular experience of being an active element in the world they navigate; and

WHEREAS, recognizing that cycling is as much of a lifestyle as it is basic transportation, a motorcycle show championship, Bell Buckle Motorcycle Days, will be held in Bell Buckle, on May 20, 2006; and

WHEREAS, this event will encourage riders from across Tennessee to come together and compete in various show classes for the right to be called an official Tennessee Champion; and

WHEREAS, Bell Buckle Motorcycle Days' proceeds will benefit the Bell Buckle Fire Department and the Bell Buckle Chamber, and this event is deserving of the designation, "The Official Tennessee Bike Show Championship"; in addition to the Championship judging, the day will also include a Poker Run, with stops at businesses in Rutherford, Moore, Coffee, and Bedford Counties, as well as musical entertainment and New Orleans Gumbo; and

WHEREAS, motorcyclists come from all walks of life, work in all occupations, and range in age from teenagers to grandparents; for many people, riding is a socially responsible form of personal mobility that saves energy, helps the environment, and provides a broad range of other public benefits; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDRED FOURTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING, that the General Assembly hereby designates Bell Buckle Motorcycle Days, as "The Official Tennessee Bike Show Championship" and urges all citizens to consider attending this championship motorcycle event.
