AN ACT relative to the flags of the United States and Tennessee.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. All official flags of the United States and of the State of Tennessee, purchased under a state contract shall be manufactured in the United States.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
