

CORRECTED FISCAL NOTE

HB 803 - SB 1433

March 1, 2005

SUMMARY OF BILL: Provides that a mission of the University of Tennessee College of Veterinary Medicine is to educate persons in preparation for large animal veterinary practice in rural areas. The criteria for admission into the College of Veterinary Medicine shall place emphasis on an applicant's experience and background in rural, agrarian areas of the state to ensure continued preparation of such large animal veterinary practices in rural areas.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

On February 24, 2005 we issued a fiscal note which indicated *an increase in state expenditures of \$345,600.*


Increase State Expenditures – Not Significant
